

**BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**  
**TUESDAY, APRIL 26, 2016**  
**9:00 A.M**

The Buffalo County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, April 26, 2016 at 9:00 A.M. Chairman McMullen called the meeting to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Board members responded to roll call: Francis Biehl, Joseph Brayton, Kent Greder, Ivan Klein, Sherry Morrow, Dennis Reiter and William McMullen. Chairman McMullen announced that in accordance with Section 84-1412 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is available for review. County Clerk Janice Giffin took all proceedings hereinafter shown; while the convened meeting was open to the public. Deputy County Attorney Kari Fisk was present.

Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Morrow, Greder, Biehl, Brayton, Klein, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

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Moved by Morrow and seconded by Greder to approve the audit contract with Tonniges & Associates Inc. for the fiscal year 2015-2016. Budget Committee Chairperson Morrow recommended that the Board set an RFP for next year. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Morrow, Greder, Biehl, Brayton, Klein, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Morrow and seconded by Greder to approve the release of pledged collateral in the amount of \$105,000.00 at the Exchange Bank for the Buffalo County Treasurer. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Morrow, Greder, Biehl, Brayton, Klein, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

Thereafter the Board considered a proposed banking resolution requested by a depository bank concerning elected and appointed county official’s use of county bank accounts and the use of Buffalo County’s Employment Identification Number (EIN) for those accounts. After discussion, it was determined that further information and details concerning this request were needed. Therefore it was moved by Morrow and seconded by Klein that the Buffalo County Attorney’s Office be authorized on behalf of this county to make contact with the depository bank(s) of the county to review the need of banking resolutions needed by the various depository banks, and if thought proper, prepare a draft resolution for consideration of this Board at the next public meeting. Further that the county depository banks are authorized by this motion to discuss policy matters and needs of banks with the Buffalo County Attorney’s Office as concerns the banking needs of county accounts. This process would allow the elected and appointed officials affected by any proposed banking resolution to have some input on any proposed banking resolution. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Morrow, Klein, Biehl, Brayton, Greder, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Brayton and seconded by Klein to approve the request from Dan Roeder Concrete for temporary access to County owned property located at 321 South Central Avenue, Kearney NE. The access will be during a road construction project from April 25 through June 30, 2016. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Brayton, Klein, Biehl, Greder, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

Chairman McMullen reviewed the following correspondence. Central Nebraska Drug Court sent an invitation for Drug Court Graduation Ceremony in Hastings. Nebraska State Historical Society sent a notice that the Gibbon Baptist Church, also known as the Gibbon Heritage Center was listed on the National Register of Historic Places. State of Nebraska Department of Roads sent information of statewide plans and programs. Darrin Lewis Emergency Manager sent the 2015 Annual Report. Chairman McMullen called on each Board member present for committee reports and recommendations.

**ZONING**

Chairman McMullen opened the Zoning Hearing at 9:20 A.M. Zoning Administrator LeAnn Klein was present. Mitchell Humphrey, on behalf of Anna Lou Hempleman, filed an administrative subdivision request for property described as part of Government Lot 1 and accretion, part of Government Lot 8 and accretion located in the Southwest Quarter of Fractional Section 27, Township 9 North, Range 13 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Buffalo County, Nebraska to be known as Kropp Administrative Subdivision. Mitchell Humphrey and Deputy County Attorney Kari Fisk were present to review the Administrative Subdivision application. Deputy County Attorney Kari Fisk reported that it does not meet the criteria for Subdivision Regulations. Chairman McMullen closed the hearing at 9:31 A.M. Moved by Greder and seconded by Brayton to approve the Administrative Subdivision application with the following Resolution 2016-20 contingent on an updated plat, which includes easements around all four property boundaries, being provided to the Zoning administrator by the applicant. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Greder, Brayton, Biehl, Klein, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

**RESOLUTION 2016-20**

WHEREAS, Mitchell Humphrey, licensed surveyor, on behalf of Anna Lou Hempleman, a single person, hereinafter referred to as “applicant” have filed for an Administrative Subdivision to be known as “KROPP ADMINISTRATIVE SUBDIVISION” with the Buffalo County Clerk and/or Zoning Administrator, and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Administrator forwarded this application to this Board, and

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2016, this Board conducted a public hearing and now finds:

1. The proposed “KROPP ADMINISTRATIVE SUBDIVISION” is in the Agricultural (AG) Zoning District for Buffalo County, Nebraska and the size of the parcels of real estate owned by the subdividing entity after subdividing complies with the minimum lot size of this zoning district.
2. The proposed plat for this subdivision fulfills Buffalo County’s Subdivision Resolution requirements for administrative subdivisions specifically allowed under Section 3.02 together with other provisions applicable thereto.
3. 39<sup>th</sup> Road and Sioux Road are County maintained roads open to the public that abut the proposed subdivision to the south and west. Sioux Road complies with the minimum width standards required by the Buffalo County Subdivision Resolution. 39<sup>th</sup> Road does not comply with minimum width standards, but is not owned by the County therefore additional road dedication is not required as it will not be accepted by the owners of 39<sup>th</sup> Road.
4. Title search paperwork has been provided to the Buffalo County Attorney’s Office and that office has cleared title as concerns Buffalo County’s interests based upon the title search documents delivered to that office by applicant.
5. This proposed administrative subdivision should be approved.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS in regular session with a quorum present, that the plat of “KROPP ADMINISTRATIVE SUBDIVISION”, an administrative subdivision being described as being part of Government Lot 1 and accretion lands deriving from and adjacent to Government Lot 1, part of Government Lot 8 and accretion lands deriving from and adjacent to Government Lot 8, all located in the Southwest Quarter of Fractional Section 27, Township 9 North, Range 13 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Buffalo County, Nebraska, duly made out, acknowledged and certified, is hereby approved, accepted, ratified, and authorized to be filed and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds, Buffalo County, Nebraska.

Jerad Reimers community liaison for Congressman Adrian Smith was present to give an update from the Congressional office to the Commissioners and asked if they had any questions for Congressman Smith.
