**Prime for Life!** (DUI or MIP) is an 8-hour alcohol education class for adults and/or youth. The goal of this program is reduce the incidence of alcohol- and other drug-related problems in adults and youth. This nationally recognized and evidence-based program focuses on personal risk-reduction (choices) and self-assessment specifically related to alcohol. The program is voluntary, however, many are referred by court, probation, or juvenile services for a Minor-In-Possession/Consumption of Alcohol (first offense), Driving Under the Influence, or another first-time alcohol- or other drug-related offense. Cost is \$70; direct school referrals are welcome at a reduced rate of \$60. Pre-registration is necessary. *This class is also offered in Spanish. Please call the number above for class times or visit the web site under Adult-minor Classes.*

**Youth Tobacco Education Class** will assist youth in learning about the legal and health risks associated with tobacco use, addiction, and offer assistance in helping them move towards quitting. Cost is \$40; no discounts for school referrals. Pre-registration is necessary. (4 hour class)

**Marijuana Education Class** (for youth ages 14 or older through adults) is an education class that helps participants understand the dangers of the use and addictive nature of marijuana, legal and health risks associated with the use of marijuana, reduce the incidence of alcohol- and other drug-related problems, and assist them in seeking further help if needed. The program is voluntary, however, many are referred by court or probation for a Possession of Marijuana (first offense), a failed drug test at a place of employment, or another first-time drug-related offense. Cost is \$40; no discounts for school referrals. Pre-registration is necessary. (4 hour class)

**Driving the Right Way** is a nationally recognized, evidence-based program designed for repeat DUI/DWI offenders, challenging the thought- and decision-making process related to drinking and driving choices. Cost is \$100, or \$80 if paid in cash in full at the first class session. Class size is limited; minimum of 5 participants required to hold this series; pre-registration is necessary.
