Sumner-Eddyville-Miller School Bond Issue

"Shall Dawson County School District 0101 (Sumner-Eddyville-Miller Schools) in the State of Nebraska Issue its bonds in a principal amount not to exceed Four Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$4,350,000) for the purposes of financing the costs of renovating, rehabilitating and improving the District's existing K-12 school building in Sumner, Nebraska, including but not limited to accessibility improvements, installation of an elevator, security and safety improvements, fire sprinklers, roof replacement and environmental hazardous abatement, constructing additions to and related site improvements for such building, and acquiring and installing necessary furniture, equipment and apparatus for such school building and additions; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to become due at such time or times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?"

"Shall the Mayor and City Council of the City of Kearney, Nebraska impose a restaurant and drinking place occupation tax commencing February 1, 2015 and terminating on or before January 31, 2025 in the amount of one percent in said City to pay the interest and principal of said bonds as the same become due?"
