**SCHOOL BOND ELECTION
AMHERST PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT 0119**

"Shall Buffalo County School District 0119 (Amherst Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its bonds in a total principal amount not to exceed Seven Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,900,000) for the purpose of financing the costs of constructing renovations of and additions to the District's existing school facility, such renovations and additions to include K-6 classrooms, a new kitchen and lunchroom/common area, locker rooms and an expansion of the industrial arts/shop area, and acquiring and installing necessary furniture, equipment and apparatus for such school building and additions; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rates, to become due at such times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?"

Electors voting in favor of said proposition shall blacken completely the oval opposite the words "FOR said bonds and tax" following said proposition, and electors voting against said proposition shall blacken completely the oval opposite the words "AGAINST said bonds and tax" following said proposition.

Proposed constitutional amendments and initiatives, titles and text will be published by the Office of the Secretary of State, once a week for 3 weeks prior to the General Election.
