

**KEARNEY AREA SOLID WASTE AGENCY
LANDFILL
COVERED LOAD POLICY
Effective June 1, 1994**

All vehicles transporting refuse or waste to the landfill must take precautions to insure that the refuse or waste materials will not be allowed to be blown, dropped or strewn from the vehicle along the roads leading to the landfill.

As a general rule the following types of waste must be securely fastened to the vehicle hauling the waste by the method indicated:

<u>Type of Waste</u>	<u>Vehicle</u>	<u>Method to Secure</u>
Yardwaste	Enclosed Vehicle Flat Bed Trailer	Completely Covered, Tarpred or Netted. When bagged and not above vehicle sides no tarp is required.
Trees	Any Type Vehicle Not Allowing Trees To Drag	Roped, Strapped, Tarpred or Netted
Household Waste	Enclosed Vehicle With End Gate	Completely Covered, Tarpred or Netted
Mixed Construction Material & Shingles	Enclosed Vehicle With End Gate	Completely Covered, Tarpred or Netted
Concrete, Asphalt, Dirt, Stone & Brick	Enclosed Vehicle With End Gate	None Required As Long As Load Does Not Exceed The Box Height At The Edge of The Box
Pallets, Lumber Furniture, Appliances	Any Type	Roped or Strapped if Materials Exceed Box Height

Commercial vehicles hauling waste which is not securely fastened will be charged an additional \$20.00 at the landfill before unloading.

Residential haulers hauling their own refuse which is not securely fastened will be charged \$10.00.
